महोदय/ महोदया,

I am forwarding herewith a list of Holidays and Restricted Holidays to be observed during the calendar year 2017 approved in the General Body meeting of central government employees welfare co-ordination committee Jammu held on 28.11.2016 for your information, guidance and necessary action. Relevant provision of the Education code should be kept in view while making out a list of Holidays for your Vidyalaya.

A complete break-up of working days and holidays including therein seven discretionary holidays as per Article-92(F) page No.120 of Education code may please be worked out and a copy of the same may please be sent to this office for records.

Whereas there is more than one KV at a station, the Principals will decide five common holidays out of RH mentioned in the list and inform to this office accordingly. The Holidays for Annual Day and Sports day may be given as per requirement of respective KV. It has been observed in the past that some of the Principals declare holidays in his/her Vidyalaya without any valid reason i.e. local festival/RH. This practice should be stopped immediately.

It is also informed that the holidays of Annual day/ Sports day is to be declared immediately after celebrating the occasion and not at any other time in the year. Deviation from these instructions will be viewed seriously and action will be taken against defaulting Principals.


